SCENE ONE

Deli Dumrul: I don't care who you are. What is in your hand?

Dracula: It is a golden cup which has caused a lot of peoblems for my country. My people fight and kill each other just to own this golden cup. I want to give it to the gods then my people will live in peace.

Deli Dumrul: You may cross the bridge if you give me 40 ackhas.

Dracula: Ohh! You fool! I think you have not heard how many people I have killed that have stood against me. Get out of my way!

Deli Dumrul: It seems you have not heard me, either. No one on earth can beat me, even the Angel of Death.

(They fight but Dracula can't beat Deli Dumrul. So, he can't cross the bridge. After a while, a woman approaches)

Dumrul: Who are you woman? What do you want?

Vlasta: I'm Vlasta, the leader of women who are dominated by men. In my country there is a war between my women and Ctirad's men. The men brutally attack and kill many women. So, I want to see Athena and ask for strength to stand against the men.

(Vlasta draws her sword and shows them to Dumrul)

Dracula: (raising the golden cup up in the air) You will see, you will see. Dumrul I'll put your blood in the cup and drink it. How dare you don't let me pass over the bridge.

Jose: Again, again, again(**wandering around angrily**) someone else has beaten me. But I will take my revenge! After Athena gives me my freedom and power, I'll kill you, Dumrul.

Vlasta: (calmly thinking) Hey men! You always find a solution by killing and violence. This time stop fighting and think wisely. Come here and sit. Calm down. We must find another solution.

Dracula: Yes, Let's kill Dumrul when he sleeps.

Jose: Vlasta, you speak to him and I'll attack him from behind.

Vlasta: No,no,no, You don't understand me, don't fight. Let us find another way.

Dracula and Joze: (both thinking) There must be another way, another way...

Vlasta: That's it! Another way to cross. Men, you are really clever. We'll build another bridge.Come on,stand up! (**turning to Joze**) You bring the wood and stones.(**turning to Dracula**) You'll teach us how to build a bridge.

Dumrul: Hmmmm.. I understand now. Vlasta couldn't beat me but she managed to organize the people. She realized her ability to organize people, reconciliate differences and cooperation.

Athena: You're right and the reality may be totally different than perceived. We are all parts of a whole and we need each other to complete the whole.

Dumrul: I see your grace, I see.. Everybody thought that I was a bad person but it was a plan. I didn't let them to cross bridge so they had to work together. Ohh...I admire your wisdom..(kneels down)

Athena: We have peace for now but I'm afraid it will not last forever. **(to the audience)** People, will forget my words and another age of war will come. However, some people will still remember my message, how happy will be the people that remember my message in their hearts.
